ep!c ACHIEVEMENTS - HARVEST

When Gabe first came to EP!C, he was a senior in high school participating in EP!C's Harvest Program for students. Like many young adults, he was unsure of what he wanted to do with his life. Gabe's teachers encouraged him to pursue his interest in EP!C's Harvest Program. Gabe trained in the EP!C Harvest garden, where he learned soil preparation, planting, garden upkeep and maintenance, plant care, harvesting and preparing for the changing seasons.

Students enrolled in EP!C's 12-week Horticultural certificate classes learn basic gardening skills including harvesting, plant health, germination and maintenance. Gabe's interest and the knowledge he gained while participating in EP!C's Harvest Program helped him enroll in horticulture classes at Illinois Central College (ICC). While there, Gabe earned a certificate in Horticultural Studies and continued on to receive his Associate's Degree.

EP!C's certification courses in Horticulture, Culinary, Technology and Employment for Autism allow individuals to explore opportunities in a career field of their interest. While enrolled in classes, students build their portfolio and resume while learning relevant skills. As a testament to their new credentials, students receive a certificate upon completion of the course.
