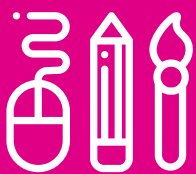


EP!C SKILLS FOR HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS

EP!C actively assists students in learning skills needed to transition to adult services. EP!C Skills is an opportunity for area high schools to bring their students to engage in various learning opportunities on a weekly basis

Over a twelve week period students will rotate through Art Education, Horticulture, and Vocational Skill Sessions.



Art Education Skills:

EP!Casso will provide students with the opportunity to explore the visual arts, study art history, and acquire an array of art skills.

Through participation, students will learn about the elements of art and the principles of design, color theory, and color schemes, as well as how to use art tools and materials



Horticulture Skills:

Through EP!C Harvest students will learn about plant care, soil preparation, planting, and basic gardening rules and safety.

Hands on learning opportunities in EP!C's Greenhouse and in the acre and a half garden is weather dependent

OPTIONAL 6-WEEK COURSE

Pre-Employment Skills:

Towards the end of the school year each group will prepare to enter the workforce by learning a few skills.

Students will spend time exploring job hunting techniques, learning processes of job application, practicing interview skills and connecting independent living skills, such as hygiene and communication skills

Vocational Skills:

Engage in vocational learning with EP!C's curriculum team in the areas of Life Skills, Culinary, and Technology.

Students will have the opportunity to expand their abilities by practicing skills that will be useful not only in a job, but in leading a more independent life.
