Over a twelve week period students will rotate through Art Education, Horticulture, and Vocational Skill Sessions.



EP!Casso will provide students with the opprotunity to explore the visual arts, study art history, and aquire an array of art skills.

Through participation, students will learn about the elements of art and the principles of design, color theory, and color scgenes, as well as how to use art tools and materials

Horticulture Skills:

Through EP!C Harvest students will learn about plant care, soil preparation planting, and basic gardening rules and saftey.
